Main areas to focus on for 2014-15 academic year will be;

- Writing for all PP children
- Maths in Y6
- Attainment/progress for Y3 in particular This will be done in a variety of ways some of which are;
 - Maths – small group tuition in Y2-4 inclusive
 - Easter school for key year groups
 - Small group phonics booster for Y2-4 and specific 1:1 phonics catch up programme
 - Training for specialised TA to run BRP (Better Reading Partnership Intervention)
 - Whole school training in feedback during lessons and in books
 - Emotional literacy training for TAs
 - Resourcing – high interest/low ability readers for KS2
 - Once baseline data set for EYFS and KS1 examine support needed for these year groups
 - Improving quality of 1st wave English teaching in particular writing – focus CPD for Y3 teachers
 - Breakfast club for vulnerable pupils who are to be encouraged to attend the schools breakfast club at no cost to ensure they have a settled and nutritious start to the day.
 - Counsellor to work with vulnerable pupils providing an opportunity for them to discuss and explore any feelings/ issues at home or at school that may be affecting them
