What patterns are hiding in your home?

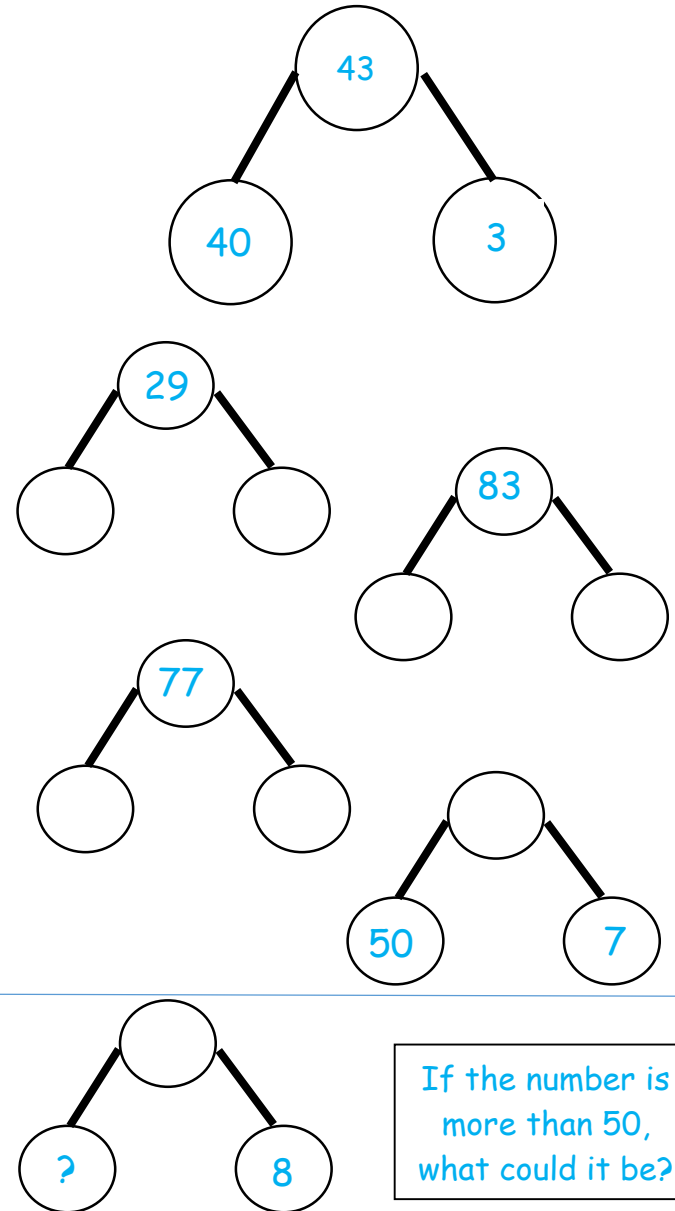
Using a crayon or pastel and some paper, collect as many different and interesting rubbings from your home or garden. These could be from trees, stones, walls or carpets!
