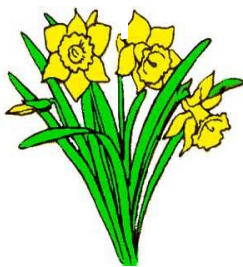

# **SUNDAY 11 MARCH 2018**

## French Cinnamon Toast (1 serving)

This is a lovely breakfast recipe to make for Mum on Mothering Sunday.

### Ingredients

- 1 large egg per person
- 40 mls. of milk
- ½ teaspoon of cinnamon
- 1 or 2 slices of bread (depending on thickness)
- Oil for cooking (we used sunflower)

### Method

- Crack the egg into a wide bowl.
- Add the milk and cinnamon.
- Whisk the mixture together.
- Dip the bread into the liquid turning it over to absorb all the mixture.
- Heat some oil in a frying pan.
- Place the soaked bread carefully into the hot oil.
- Cook for several minutes on each side.
- Repeat the process for the number of servings required.
- Serve and eat immediately.

Here are some fruity ideas to decorate the French toast.

**Mixed berries** . We used a combination of strawberries, blackberries, redcurrants and blackcurrants (defrosted).

**Morello cherry compote**

“Apple fluff” - apple (cooking variety) sweetened with sugar and cooked in the microwave until soft and fluffy. Check fruit after several minutes. Continue cooking as necessary.
