PARENT GOVERNOR VACANCY

In October 2019 we advertised a vacancy on our governing board for a parent governor representative. In December 2019 the application period closed and we had one application for the parent governor representative. As there was only one application there will be no need to hold a parent governor election. The parent who applied to be a parent governor will now go before the governing body for consideration.

However, we now have a second parent governor vacancy and are opening up a second application period. This application period will remain open until Friday 14th February 2020. If you would be interested in applying to be a parent governor you can collect an application form from the School Office, or download the copy attached. What does being a School Governor involve?

As a governor you will be part of a corporate body known as the Governing Board. The role of the governing board is critical to the effectiveness of St. Catherine's School.

Governors come from every walk of life and there is no requirement for you to have an educational background. Your exact role will be discussed with the Chair of Governors, but will always contribute to the over-arching work of the governing body and link to the main focus of St. Catherine's School, thus ensuring our children and young people are able to achieve to the best of their ability, in a safe environment.

So, what would I have to do?

Commit to attend;

- Full Governing Body Meetings (1 per term, 2 hours long)
- A Committee Meeting (1 per term, 1.5 hours long)
- Attend training
- Make visits to the school during the day
- Work as a team
