

## Lighter Eton Mess

This dessert recipe is found online in the recipe section of BBC Food. It is based on the traditional English summer dessert which is made with strawberries and thick cream.

### Ingredients (serves 4)

4 meringue nests  
300g strawberries halved  
300ml plain yoghurt

### Method

Put the meringue nests into a freezer bag and scrunch them up until they are broken into pieces. Mash half of the strawberries until nearly smooth. Mix half of the crushed meringue through the yoghurt. Layer all the ingredients into serving glasses, starting with the crushed strawberries.

Top with some of the halved strawberries and some of the remaining crushed meringue. Serve immediately.

\*If you know someone who grows mint, why not decorate your dessert with a couple of fresh mint leaves. Mint compliments strawberries/raspberries and make makes this dessert look very attractive.

\*\*This recipe works really well with raspberries. If using raspberries which have been defrosted, they are easier to mash and really juicy.

You could have the best of both worlds and use crushed raspberries in layers and decorate the top with halved strawberries!

This dessert is easily doubled or halved as required.
